Participant/Parent Agreement (must be signed by all parents and participants)

It is important that all campers, parents and staff members have full understanding of, and be in agreement with, the overall Cheley philosophy, ideals and goals related to group living.

The Cheley Camp program is an active, outdoor, group living experience of a positive and constructive nature. Our program requires full and complete participation from all campers.

We serve young people from all 50 states, in addition to many international campers. All major faiths are represented in our camp community, and the camp programs are open to people of high character, who are emotionally well, and physically fit, without regard to race, color or creed. We do, however, reserve the right to refuse admittance to or release any individual from the program. We are not a treatment center.

1. It is understood and agreed by the campers, parents and staff that there shall be no smoking or use of smokeless tobacco.
2. There shall be no drinking of alcoholic beverages on the camp property or on any camp program away from camp property.
3. It is further understood and agreed that there will be no use of, or involvement in marijuana, narcotics, or controlled substances or any accompanying drug equipment.
4. Weapons and firearms are not permitted, with the sole exception of the camp's supervised instructional programs in archery and riflery, using equipment provided by the camp.
5. It is understood by the camp that participants and their parents will read all materials sent and complete all forms required for participation in the Cheley Colorado Camps program.
6. It is understood that all aspects of my relationship and my child's relationship with Cheley and its agents and employees shall be governed by the laws of the state of Colorado.

In the event of an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the camp director to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and to order injection, anesthesia, or surgery for myself or my family named above. **I have read, understand, and will comply with the terms of the Participant/Parent Agreements.**

Waiting Lists

Applications are accepted until all space is filled. At that time, a numerical waiting list is started with names added as applications and the required deposit are received at the camp office. No names will be placed on the waiting list without the required deposit. If we are unable to confirm a registration, we will refund the entire deposit.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations due to medical reasons must be accompanied by a letter from the attending physician; tuition will be refunded minus the non-refundable deposit. Any withdrawal after the start of the camp term, at the request of parents or the camp for behavior or personal reasons, will forfeit the full camp fee. In case of accident or illness, if the camper returns home upon the recommendation of the camp doctor, the unused portion of the term will be refunded.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT & ASSUMPTION OF RISKS AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS FOR MINORS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING. THIS DOCUMENT INCLUDES A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.

In consideration for our family being permitted to participate in camping activities at Cheley Colorado Camps, Inc. ("Cheley"),

agree to the following provisions:

Acknowledgements of Risks

I understand that there are numerous risks associated with participation in any camping activities, including hiking, horseback riding, archery, riflery, technical climbing, crafts and transportation to and from camp activities. Many, but not all, of these risks are inherent in these and other activities. These risks, which contribute to the unique character and desirability of the activities involved, pose the possibility of severe injury, illness or death. I further understand that the activities involved will take place in an outdoor environment in mountainous terrain. For this and other reasons, the risks cannot be eliminated, altered or controlled.

Some, but not all, of the specific risks include: Weather conditions which may change rapidly and unpredictably and may cause injury directly (for example, rain or hail storms, sunburn, lightning strikes, cold temperatures and the like) or by acting upon other factors (for example, performance of equipment may be impaired by weather conditions).

Equipment used in the activity may break, fail or malfunction despite reasonable maintenance and use. Some of the equipment used in activities may inflict injuries even when used as intended. Persons using equipment may lose control of such equipment and cause injury to themselves and to others.

Most activities take place in a natural environment where unexpected, unseen and unmarked objects and conditions create risk of injury or death from falling, tripping, slipping, insect or animal contact, unstable surface conditions, falling rocks and objects, potentially harmful vegetation and the like.

Horses, which are involved in some activities, are sometimes unpredictable and may act in unexpected ways and may respond in unexpected ways to such things as sounds, movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, other animals, automobiles and weather conditions.

Activities near or in the water, such as rafting, fishing, hiking, horseback riding, and the like involve risk of injury, illness or drowning. Because they are in a natural environment, lakes, ponds, streams, rivers and creeks present risks of water movement, subsurface conditions, cold water temperatures, water impurities and the like. There is also a risk of falling out of or being struck by water craft.

Counselors and guides use their best judgment in determining how to react to circumstances, including weather, terrain, water conditions, animal character and other unpredictable natural phenomena. The counselors and guides may misjudge such circumstances, an individual's capabilities and the like.

Motor vehicle accidents may occur in the course of transporting camp participants to or from activities.

These are some, but not all, of the risks inherent in camping activities; a complete listing of inherent and other risks is not possible. There are also risks which cannot be anticipated.

I (we) give permission for our family to participate in all camp activities, including those described above. I acknowledge and assume the risks involved in these activities, and for any damage, illness, injury or death resulting from such risks for myself and my family. There are no physical, emotional, mental problems or limitations associated with myself or my family's participation in camp activities, except as disclosed by me in writing to Cheley Colorado Camps.

Warning

Under Colorado law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes.

Release, Waiver of Liability and Indemnification

I, on behalf of myself and my family, hereby release and waive any claim of liability against Cheley Colorado Camps and its employees and agents, with respect to any injury, illness, damage or death occurring to myself or any member of my family while we participate in any and all camp programs and activities.

I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless Cheley Colorado Camps, Inc. and its employees and agents with respect to any claim asserted by or on behalf of myself or my family as a result of injury, illness, damage or death.

Governing Law

I agree that this document and all other aspects of myself and my family's relationship with Cheley and its employees and agents shall be governed by the laws of the state of Colorado. Further, I agree that any legal proceeding concerning such relationship must be filed exclusively in the state of Colorado.
